

## DISTRICT OF HIGHLANDS

### BYLAW NO. 164

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A JOINT PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION WITH THE CITY OF COLWOOD, DISTRICT OF LANGFORD, DISTRICT OF METCHOSIN, AND CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT.

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WHEREAS the Council may by bylaw establish a parks and recreation program, establish a joint parks and recreation commission, and delegate the Council's powers to the commission in accordance with sections 176, 246, 517 and 518.1 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the parties intend to enter into an agreement setting out the terms and conditions for the operation of parks and recreation services in Langford, Colwood, Highlands, Metchosin and the Juan de Fuca Electoral Area;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the District of Highlands, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as 'West Shore Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw No. 164, 2001.'
2. The Council establishes a parks and recreation service that includes the operation of the parks and recreation facilities and programs within the scope of the agreement attached to this Bylaw as Schedule A.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute a service agreement with the City of Colwood, District of Langford, District of Metchosin and Capital Regional District in the form attached as Schedule A.
4. The West Shore Parks and Recreation Commission (the 'Commission'), the terms of reference for which are attached as Schedule E to the Service Agreement, is established.
5. The Council delegates to the Commission all of the administrative powers of the municipality with respect to the equipping, maintenance, management and operation of the facilities identified in Schedule A, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Commission may establish scales of admission charges, appoint and terminate its own staff, determine operational rules and procedures and recreation programs, collect all revenues from, and pay expenses of those facilities.


READ a FIRST TIME on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2001.
