BYLAW NO. 255

A BYLAW TO AMEND "HIGHLANDS ZONING BYLAW NO. 100, 1998"

The Council of the District of Highlands in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. That "Highlands Zoning Bylaw No. 100, 1998" be amended as follows:

a) Under Section 1 "Definitions", the following new definition be added:

"SWIMMING POOL" means any *structure* or construction, intended primarily for recreational purposes that is, or is capable of being, filled with water to a depth of 0.45 metres (18 inches) or more, which does not include, but is not limited to, fish or ornamental ponds, irrigation ponds, natural ponds or those constructed along a natural watercourse, sealed tanks or pools fitted with a lockable cover capable of supporting the weight of a 68 kilogram (150 pound) person, when closed.

2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Highlands Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 255, 2005."
