



**(B) Survey Results**

A summary of the 61 survey forms received by the date of this meeting was presented. Discussion of the results recognized the approximate 10% return rate and the extent to which the results were representative of community preference.

**1. Home -based Businesses**

The APC is supportive of this existing, permitted land use and will return to the issue when the regulatory details are prepared for the zoning bylaw.

**2. Secondary Suites**

Much discussion ensued on the principle and the technical aspects of this land use which is not currently permitted in the zoning bylaw.
