HIGHLANDS OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE

The District of Highlands Official Community Plan is being revised to better align its vision with the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan (ICSP). The ICSP represents nearly 4 years of work by the Highlands Sustainability Task Force and the Sustainability Strategy Advisory Committee, and was created to help guide the Highlands to a more sustainable future. Many sections of the draft OCP revision remain the same as the existing OCP, however some areas are substantially changed. New sections have been added on local food, energy and greenhouse gas emissions, and development permit areas. Broad community input and comment on the OCP revisions is needed in advance of a Public Hearing and the reading of bylaws to adopt the plan. There will be several opportunities in the next month to share your views and discuss the plan revisions:
