UPCOMING PUBLIC HEARING INFORMA-

TION Application RZ-01-11 (applicant Fred York) seeks to increase the density of the lands (shown cross-hatched (shown in the map on left) if the lands noted as, "Proposed Land Donation," (shown shaded in map on left) are donated to the District of Highlands for a

community centre/hall location. The proposal would increase the density to a total of 11 single family dwellings (there are currently two homes over this area). An Official Community Plan amendment and a zoning bylaw amendment are required to accomplish the proposal. Highlands Council gave the OCP amendment bylaw (Bylaw No. 330) and the zoning amendment bylaw (Bylaw No. 331) first and second readings at their June 6, 2011 Council Meeting. As required by legislation, the District will hold a public hearing on both bylaws on July 18, 2011 at 7 p.m. at the School House, 1589 Millstream Road. The regularly scheduled Council Meeting will follow immediately after.
