Mufaro Marimaba Band and Rupert Wates will perform for the open stage segment

The musicians in Mufaro Marimba are: Bernie Martin-Wood, Jen Mutch, Dana Barber, Lizanne Chicanot, Barb Roberts, Marti Wood, Dawne Kirwan and guest Chad DeCorte. Mostly traditional pieces rearranged for marimbas, the music is happy and fun to play and uplifting to listen to.

One of the best things about their music is that it is attractive to a very wide cross section of people - from young in age to young at heart. It's hard to keep your body still when you listen to them, and you feel like getting up, moving and dancing!

Also performing during the open stage segment is Rupert Wates who is a singer-songwriter, born in London, based in the USA since 2007. His material is acoustic, melodic art/folk, with a strong emphasis on narrative and songs based on true stories. In the four years since he came to the US, Rupert Wates has won twenty five song-writing awards. His CDs 'Coast To Coast' (2007), 'Dear Life' (2008) and 'Joe's Cafe' (2010) have all been played regularly by radio stations in the US, Canada, The Netherlands, Germany, Israel and Australia.
