At both its March 12 and April 9 Committee of the Whole (COW) meetings, Council received presentations from Chris Coates, Chief Administrative and Financial Officer, outlining a draft 2012 budget. With final information from other jurisdictions such as CRD still due, council reviewed each item and noted

> that increases in requisitions are due to the District's increased population as well as assessed property values.

> The draft budget proposes a small increase (1.56%) in municipal property taxes. The district has historically aimed at a 0% increase by keeping services and expenditures lean. However, with the increased cost of every item purchased in order to do business it is proposed to consider sound financial management and planning practices during this year's budget process.
