**AMENITY PARCEL (YORK REZONING)** One of the amenity parcels provided through the recent York rezoning was recommended as the preferred site for a future community hall by the Community Centre Task Force. In order to build a community hall - and make use of a provincial "Town for Tomorrow" grant for construction costs - on the parcel, it requires rezoning. The terms of the grant require a construction completion date of March 31, 2013. At the October 17th meeting, Council authorized staff to proceed with the rezoning process.
