Evenings at the Highlands Coffee House are filled with great music, a good variety of musicians, dessert and people who enjoy music and great events to go to with friends, neighbours and family.

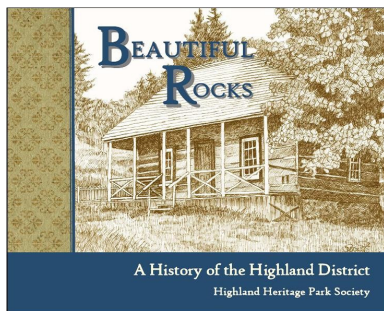
