# How Do You Spell... H.E.L.P.?

Recent catastrophic earthquakes in Japan and Haiti serve as a sobering reminder of our vulnerability to a similar event here. **THIS IS THE TIME** to review the contents of your family emergency supplies kit and your plans in the event of a catastrophic emergency.

In the Highlands we have established neighbourhood regions known as Highland Emergency Local Preparedness (HELP) Groups, on the understanding that the greatest source of support in a catastrophic emergency will be neighbour to neighbour.

We have established HELP Groups in a number of areas, but we still need to organize groups in the following locations:

River Rd; Hannington Estates; Finlayson Arm Rd; Taylor Way; Davies Rd; Lorimer & Blacktail Rds; Millstream (middle)/Emma Dixon; Caleb Pike (South); Highlands Estates (North & South); Emma Dixon Rd; Hazlett Creek / Old Mossy; Munn Rd (Lower)/Rolla Pl; Woodridge/Blue Valley/ Eagles Lake; Westridge PL; Compton Rd./Bukin Dr. West; and Bukin Pl.
