

№ District of Highlands – Development Permit Areas (DPAs) FAQ Sheet

What Are Development Permit Areas?

Under the <u>Local Government Act</u>, municipalities can designate **Development Permit Areas (DPAs)** in their <u>Official Community Plan</u> to protect sensitive land features.

In the District of Highlands, DPAs help manage:

- Steep slopes
- Water and riparian areas
- Sensitive vegetation and ecosystems

Do I Need a Permit?

If your property is within a DPA, you must obtain a **<u>Development Permit</u>** before:

- Constructing a building
- Adding to or altering an existing structure
- Altering land and or removing vegetation/trees
- Subdividing land
