They are a vital part of the Highlands' natural environment and community character.

Do I Need a Permit to Cut Trees?

Yes. The <u>Tree Management Bylaw No. 10, 1994</u> regulates and prohibits the cutting of trees in the District.

Before starting any construction project—or removing hazardous, damaged, dying, or dead trees—check if a **tree cutting permit** is required.
